A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MARIETTA, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
TO APPOINT ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE ZONING HEARING BOARD

WHEREAS, the Borough of Marietta has enacted a Zoning Ordinance and established a Zoning Hearing Board in accordance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code ("MPC"); and

WHEREAS, Section 903 of the MPC provides that members and alternate members of Zoning Hearing Boards are to be appointed by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to appoint a replacement member due to the death of Robert Carroll of the Zoning Hearing Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Marietta, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 903(b) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10903(b), Council appoints the following person as a replacement member of the Zoning Hearing Board of Marietta Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, with the terms of office expiring as set forth below:

Section 2. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution, it being the intent of Council that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
