

RESOLUTION 02-2011
AMENDING ESTABLISHED FEE STRUCTURE OF THE
HOUSING STANDARDS, CHAPTER 52, ARTICLE II, SECTION 52-7
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MARIETTA BOROUGH

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Marietta that the following fee structure is hereby established to the Housing Standards, Chapter 52, Article II-Inspections, Section 52-7 as follows:

- A. All owners of dwelling units and/or rooming units and/or Bed & Breakfast units, as defined in Chapter 52, shall pay to the Borough of Marietta, as part of the inspection process set forth in the preceding sections, a fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per hour for the inspector's time, billed in increments of fifteen (15) minutes and a fee of twenty-eight dollars (\$28.00) per hour for administrative services provided by the Borough's Deputy Administrative Assistant, billed in increments of fifteen (15) minutes.
- B. With regards to the issuance of the rental permit set forth in the preceding sections, a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) will be accessed per unit.
- C. Follow-up inspection may sometimes be required to confirm that required corrections have been made. A fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per hour for the inspector's time, billed in increments of fifteen (15) minutes, will be accessed for each follow-up inspection and it is the intent of sub-section 52-6 and this section that all required corrections be made within the time specified by the Housing Officer and prior to the follow-up inspection.
- D. If the Housing Officer must make more than one (1) follow-up inspection to confirm corrections or if the Housing Office must return to the property additional times because the owner did not make the property accessible at the designated time for any inspections, then an additional fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per unit shall be paid for each and every such additional inspections.
