Illicit Discharge / Water Quality Issue Reporting Form



What is an Illicit Discharge?

-Federal regulations define an illicit discharge as "any discharge to an MS4 that is not composed entirely of stormwater..." with some exceptions. These exceptions include discharges from NPDESpermitted industrial sources and discharges from fire-fighting activities.

Illicit discharges (see below) are considered "illicit" because MS4s are not designed to accept, process, or discharge such non-stormwater wastes.

Potential Sources of Illicit Discharges

- Sanitary Wastewater
- Waste From Septic Tanks
- Car Wash Wastewaters
- Improper Oil Disposal
- Radiator Flushing Disposal
- Laundry Wastewaters
- Spills From Roadway Accidents
- Improper Disposal of Auto and Household Toxins
